

## **International Moon Day from Chile - ACHIDE**

### **1. Event summary (number of participants, location, partners, etc.)**

1) Sunday 16, July. Activities for general public at Rancagua Regional Museum (City of Rancagua, Chile); hybrid event with 15 people in little auditorium (pandemic restriction still apply in Chile) and people on line in zoom and Youtube channel. We produced 2 videos with 1188 and 88 views until today. Activity organized by ACHIDE's Education Committee and following partners organizations: "Marteens, astronauts school", Universidad Técnica Federico Santa María; Fuerza Aérea de Chile; Sociedad Chilena de Astronomía.

2) Wednesday 20, July. Conference about "Chile and the future of the Moon", at the Chilean Engineering Association's auditorium (City of Santiago, Chile); hybrid event with 10 people at place and people connected on line by zoom and Youtube channel. We produced 2 videos with 250 and 474 views until today. Activity organized by ACHIDE's Education Committee and the following partners: Colegio de Ingenieros de Chile; Fuerza Aérea de Chile; Universidad Técnica Federico Santa María; Sociedad Chilena de Astronomía.

3) Wednesday 20, July. Conference by the National Science Award Ms. Monica Rubio, at the Observatory Cerro Calan (City of Santiago, Chile); Hybrid event with 40 people at place and people connected on line by Zoom and Youtube channel. We produced 1 video with 492 views until today. Activity organized by ACHIDE's Education Committee and the following partners: Sociedad Chilena de Astronomía; Colegio de Ingenieros de Chile; Fuerza Aérea de Chile; Universidad Técnica Federico Santa María; Ministerio de Ciencias Tecnología Conocimiento e Innovación; sponsored by Airbus Defense & Space.
