- At the global or regional levels
 - through Regional or National
 - Coordinators
- Large event with major partners

Bottom-up is now <u>Global Events</u>

- Anyorganization/ individual local event
- Small events with in-kind resources
- Requires Prequalifying & Registration at the official IMD-G website
